

SINGAPORE BRACHYTHERAPY SYMPOSIUM 2011: HDR IN THE 3D ERA 9-11 MARCH 2011

Course Description

Brachytherapy remains a time-honoured and important component of radiation therapy for cancer. While advances made in improved imaging and targeting of tumours have resulted in more effective external beam radiotherapy, Brachytherapy techniques have also evolved.

The primary focus of the Singapore Brachytherapy Symposium, therefore, is to review the principles and practices of BRT and update participants on the current status of HDR BRT in the image-guided era.

The symposium will cover various issues related to clinical practice and implementation of a comprehensive 3D-HDR BRT programme with special focus on transition from 2D to 3D-HDR BRT for cervical cancer, 3D-HDR BRT for breast and prostate cancer.

Who Should Attend

Radiation oncologists, medical physicists, medical dosimetrists, radiation therapists and nurses interested in implementing 3D-HDR BRT into clinical practice.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of this symposium, participants should be able to:

1. Understand the basics principles of HDR BRT as practised in the era of 3D oncology, imaging
2. Acquire hands-on experience with tumour contouring, treatment-planning and dose-prescribing in the clinical practice of 3D-HDR BRT for breast and prostate cancers.
3. Be familiar with the basic requirements for establishing 3D-HDR BRT as part of a comprehensive cancer treatment service
