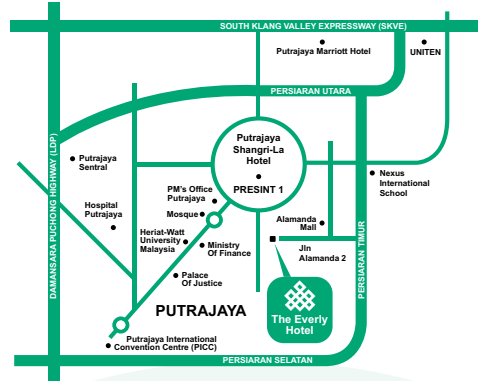

Instructions For Abstracts

1. Language: **English**
2. Font: **Arial** (11)
3. The whole abstract should not exceed **300 words**.
4. Format of Abstract:
Title (Capitalised and Bold), Name(s) of Author(s) with the presenter's name in **BOLD PRINT**; the surname of each author precedes the initials eg *Abdullah BJJ*
5. Institution(s) of the author(s): Authors from different institutions will be identified by matching superscripts eg *Kumar G¹, Ong KT², Departments of Radiology¹ and Surgery²*
6. Body of Abstract: (Each subheader in **bold** print)
 - a) Purpose of Study
 - b) Materials and Method
 - c) Results
 - d) Conclusion
7. Accepted poster for presentation will be provided with a panel space measuring **1metre(W) X 2.5metre(H)**. Authors are to ensure their poster dimensions do not exceed the space provided.
8. All abstracts must be received by the secretariat by **30 June 2015**

Tips for Visitors To Malaysia

KLIA or KLIA 2 arrival

After clearing Customs, you may head for the registered airport limo counter or the KLIA Transit train Counter for a ticket to ride to Putrajaya & Cyberjaya station (single journey fare at RM6.20 for adults & RM3.00 for children). The train ride will take approximately 10 minutes. From the Putrajaya & Cyberjaya station, please take a taxi to the hotel.

Arrival by rail

From KL Sentral, take the KLIA Transit train to Putrajaya & Cyberjaya station. The train ride will take approximately 20 minutes (single journey fare at RM9.50 for adults and RM4.50 for children). From the Putrajaya & Cyberjaya station, please take a taxi to the hotel.

Arrival by road

If you are arriving by express bus at KL Sentral or at Terminal Bersepadu Selatan (TBS) at Bandar Tasik Selatan, you may also take the KLIA Express to Putrajaya & Cyberjaya station. Alternatively, you may catch a taxi from TBS and head directly to the hotel.

If you are driving into Putrajaya through Kuala Lumpur town, try to arrive during off-peak hours. Otherwise, you will be caught in traffic jams from most entry points into the city. The peak hours are usually from 7.30am-9.30am into the city in the mornings and 4.30pm-7.30pm out of the city in the evenings. Downpours will lead to premature and extended jams.

Language

(Bahasa Melayu) Malay is the national language in use, but English is widely spoken. The ethnic groups also converse in various languages and dialects.

Religion

Islam is the official religion of the country, but other religions are widely practised.

Weather

The country experiences tropical weather year-round. Temperatures are from 21°C (70°F) to 32°C (90°F). Higher elevations are much colder with temperatures between 15°C (59°F) to 25°C (77°F). Annual rainfall varies from 2,000mm to 2,500mm.

Currency

The monetary unit of the country is Ringgit Malaysia and is written as RM. The exchange rate is valued at USD1 = RM3.63 (subject to currency fluctuation). Foreign currencies can be exchanged at banks and money changers.

Time

Eight hours ahead of GMT and 16 hours ahead of U.S Standard Time.

Electricity

Voltage is 220 - 240 Volt AC at 50 cycles per second. Standard 3- pin square plugs and socket.
