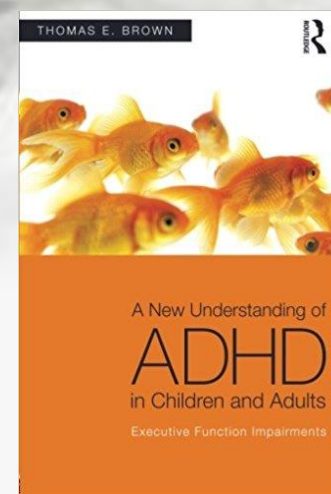
# Professor Thomas E. Brown

*A New Understanding of ADHD in Children and Adults*



Prof Brown is a clinical psychologist who received his Ph.D. from Yale University and specializes in assessment and treatment of children, adolescents and adults with ADHD. He had served as Associate Director of the Yale Clinic for Attention & Related Disorders for 20 years and recently accepted an appointment as Adjunct Clinical Associate Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at the Keck School of Medicine of the University of Southern California.

In his publications and lectures, Prof Brown describes the many, often unrecognized, ways in which ADHD interferes with daily life in school, work, social relationships, and family life.
